



## CONTINUING COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Each year St. Mary's Lutheran Church Endowment Foundation awards a limited number of scholarships to students who are communicant members of St. Mary's and are enrolled as full-time students at an accredited college or technical school. No scholarships will be awarded for travel or graduate, post-graduate or professional study. Scholarships are to be used for tuition, fees, and books, supplies and/or equipment required for courses of instruction. **All students are reviewed on the same scale and late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**

In order to be considered for a scholarship, it is necessary for a student to submit all of the following supporting documentation:

- **Application**
- **Most Current Grade Transcript**
- **Essay**
- **Resume of achievements/accomplishments, school involvement, community involvement, St. Mary's or other church involvement, and work experience, in this past year only.**

## PROCEDURES

1. Applications will be available in the Church Office, the west end of the Fellowship Hall and on-line beginning March 1. Completed Applications must be received in the Church Office by 4:00 p.m. April 30, or postmarked on or before April 30. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**
2. Submit the completed application form, GPA transcripts, essay and resume and any other supporting materials, flat in a large envelope addressed to:

3. The Scholarship Committee of the Foundation will review applications received and make a recommendation to the Board. Applicants will be notified of the Foundation Board's decision. Checks for one-half of each scholarship will be awarded to the students during the church service on a date to be determined by the committee.

Checks for the other half of the scholarships may be picked up after the Scholarship Committee receives a dated transcript with your fall semester grades and evidence of acceptance for the second semester. **Any portions of scholarships not claimed by March 1<sup>st</sup>, will be returned to the Foundation.**
