## **CURRENT CONDITIONS IN AFGHANISTAN**

The constant threat to life continues for both those Afghans resettled in the U.S. and those left behind in Afghanistan. The Taliban continues a Totalitarian stranglehold on the country. When the Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) [also known as the Afghan National Defense and Security Forces {ANDSF}] fights to defend territory, the Taliban retaliates by conducting house-by-house searches in the regions being protected by the ANSF. The Taliban seeks weapons and ANSF soldiers. If weapons are found, they are confiscated and used against resisters. If soldiers are found, they are publicly executed-as are their families-as a warning to anyone who resists Taliban control. Whether the Taliban finds either (or not), they pull innocent men, women, and children into the public where they are slaughtered as a message to anyone who resists. Any sort of resistance is met with death. The families, friends, and associates of Afghans resettled in other countries are in imminent danger, as well. *This is the reason for the confidentiality surrounding our SMLC men*.

## PROGRESS ALONG THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD

In the state of Wisconsin, those seeking a driver's license can take the test five (5) times during a twelve (12) month time period. The state reports that fifty per cent (50%) of those taking the test the first time fail. The Afghan men have each taken the test three (3) times without success: once, by computer, in English (unassisted); once, by computer, in English (with an interpreter); once, on paper, in a language similar to theirs, but not in their dialect (unassisted). Wisconsin does not offer the test in their dialect. While each man has made marked progress learning English, language acquisition continues to be a barrier to full assimilation, at this point.
